### **MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS**

### Member

A member shall be defined as a person holding a valid license or certificate of registration as a professional engineer, an engineer-in-training or engineer intern, issued under the laws of any state, territory, possession or district of the United States or the equivalent under the laws of any other country, or a retired engineer who obtained and retained a valid license or certificate while in active practice in the profession until retirement.

### Student Member

A student member shall be defined as a person who is enrolled full-time in an ABET-accredited engineering program or an engineering or pre-engineering program that has a transfer agreement with one or more ABET-accredited engineering program(s). Students enrolled full-time in a graduate-level engineering program may choose any grade for which they are eligible, including student member.
